The purpose of this memo is to provide an update on the status of my review and appointment recommendations for the Lombard Zoning Board of Appeals (ZBA). First and foremost, thank you for your efforts in communicating the current vacancies and calling for new applicants from across the community. It is my understanding that since July 1, the Village has received over 50 applications for our 12 vacant positions spread out amongst six (6) statutory commissions and localized committees. I am confident that the applications submitted will provide us with highly qualified and involved volunteers to help provide guidance to the Village Board on key policy and development issues. In addition, for those not selected, I know that we will have a deep bench to go to when future vacancies arise.

With regards to the ZBA, there are presently two (2) vacancies for which a total of two (2) applications were received. I requested that ZBA Chair John DeFalco conduct an interview process of the applicants. With the assistance of staff, John met with the interested parties in late August. Each of them is a qualified individual seeking to serve the community. Upon consideration of the candidates, I am recommending the appointment of the following residents to fill the two (2) vacant positions on the ZBA:

Brian Conway has been a Lombard resident for eighteen (18) years and expressed a willingness to be engaged in the community. He is a practicing attorney with a focus upon corporate law by profession. He has been actively involved within the community, most notably with volunteer efforts at St. Pius X School.

Zach Meadows has been a resident for forty (40) years. Currently a stay-at-home father, he has over 25 years combined in the construction industry and various entrepreneurial businesses experiences. He is currently the President of the Board of Trustees for the Bethel Presbyterian Church in Wheaton, a Lombard Park District volunteer soccer coach, and has had various roles assisting kids in you sports and dance.

A copy of the applications submitted for the above recommended candidates are attached to this memo. Please note that personal information including phone number, email and address have been redacted due to privacy concerns as this document will be included on a posted agenda.

Again, thank you for your efforts in communicating the vacant positions and assisting with the process.
