  - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposals Dated: August 27, 2019 and June 10, 2020
  - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. Contractor shall not delegate the duties involved in the performance of the services which are the subject matter of this Contract without the written approval of the Village.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village requires that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall

not issue payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.

- 5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.

The Village exercised the 2022-2023 contract extension on August 6, 2021. The Village Board of Trustees approved the 2022 Maintenance of Traffic Signal Equipment contract effective from 12:01 a.m. January 1, 2022 until 12:00 midnight, December 31, 2022. The contract unit prices are adjusted by a one-time increase of four percent (4%) for the two-year extension. The increased prices will be in effect throughout the entire two-year extension.
