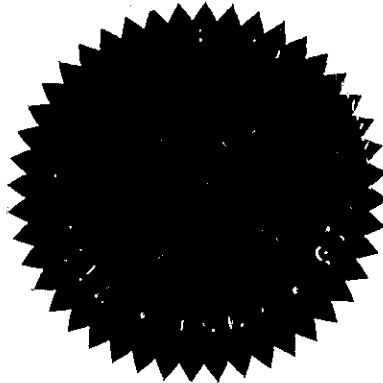

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL


