Highland Turn Restriction Adjustment

Highland Avenue currently has traffic restrictions between Maple Avenue and St. Charles Road to prevent cutthrough traffic. The current restriction is 7-10 a.m. and 4-8 p.m, Monday through Friday. In July 2014, the Police Works Department received a petition to adjust the No Left Turn restriction to 7-9 a.m. from Maple and 4-7 p.m. from St. Charles. Staff recommended approval of the adjustment according to the petition.

During the September 8, 2014 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend changing the traffic restriction in accordance with staff recommendation and the resident petition after sending a letter to affected residents. Staff sent written notice to all affected residents dated September 10th.

During the October 13, 2014 meeting, staff reported the results of the letter distribution, and the Committee confirmed their decision to recommend changing the traffic restriction.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XIV of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186), section F entitled NO LEFT TURN is amended to change the following restriction:

"4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m." to "7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m."

Section 2: That Schedule XIV of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186), section G entitled NO LEFT TURN is amended to change the following restriction:

"4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m." to "4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m."

<u>Section 3:</u> That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
