RE: Bituminous Patching Materials Contract for FY2005

On May 1, 2003, the Village Board approved a contract with DuPage Materials Company of Lemont and a contract with Du-Kane Asphalt of Addison for Bituminous Patching Materials. In the bid documents was a provision to extend the contracts for one additional year. Attached are letters from with DuPage Materials Company and Du-Kane Asphalt dated April 1, 2004, indicating their willingness to provide the same service at the listed pricing for an additional year.

To exercise the renewal option, the Village Attorney has stated that this item must be approved by a motion of the Village Board. There is no need to sign a new contract. If approved by the Board, staff would send confirming letters with signature space for DuPage Materials and Du-Kane Asphalt to accept extension of the contract. They have provided good service during the past year. I would recommend renewal of the contracts for one additional year under the same terms, conditions and prices as last year for the next fiscal year. Please note, that when the extension is approved by the Board, Public Works will purchase Cold Mix Bituminous Patching Materials from DuPage Materials, Inc. and will purchase all Hot Mix Bituminous Patching Materials from Du-Kane Asphalt in an amount not to exceed \$97,810.00 for any combination of the bituminous materials. I would also request a waiver of bids at this time.


