

SUBJECT: Amendment to Title 1, Chapter 10, Section 10.11 (Official Time)

In 2005 the United States Congress signed into law the 2005 Energy Policy Act which changed U.S. energy policy and amended the previously enacted Uniform Time Act of 1966. One of the amendments of this Act provided for lengthening Daylight Saving Time for an additional 4-5 weeks depending on the year. This amendment went into effect March 1, 2007.

Title 1, Section 10.11 of the Village Code outlines provisions as to the official time used by the Village with reference made to Daylight Saving Time. In keeping with the 2005 Energy Policy Act, staff recommends amending our code to reflect the start and end dates of Daylight Saving Time as follows:

Change the "Last Sunday in April" to the "Second Sunday in March" and
Change the "Last Sunday in October" to the "First Sunday of November"

Proposed changes to the attached ordinance are denoted by bolding **new text** and striking ~~old text~~.

RECOMMENDATION

Please place this item on the May 6, 2010 Village Board agenda for consideration. Staff recommends that the Corporate Authorities approve an Ordinance amending Title 1, Chapter 10, Section 10.11 (A)&(B) to incorporate the amended dates as outlined in the 2005 Energy Policy Act. Staff recommends a waiver of first reading of the Ordinance.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 10,
SECTION 10.11 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
OFFICIAL TIME**

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard maintains a Code of Ordinances, which is found in the Code of Lombard, Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, Title 1, Chapter 10, Section 10.11 of the Code of Lombard, Illinois includes provisions as to the Official Time used within the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2005 the Energy Policy Act of 2005 was signed into law by the United States Congress in an attempt to combat growing energy problems; and

WHEREAS, Section 110(a) of the 2005 Energy Act amended Section 3(a) of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 by changing Daylight Saving Time from the "first Sunday of April" to the "second Sunday of March" and "the last Sunday of October" was amended to the "first Sunday of November, in order to increase the length of Daylight Saving Time four (4) to five (5) weeks longer depending on the year; and

WHEREAS, Section 110 (b) of the 2005 Energy Act mandated that this change take effect March 1, 2007.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD
OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY,
ILLINOIS, as follows:**

SECTION 1: That Title 1, Chapter 10, Sections 10.11(A) & (B) of the Lombard Village Code are hereby amended to coincide with the Energy Policy Act of 2005 to read as follows:

(A) Central Standard time shall be the official time within the village for the transaction of all village business; provided, that from 2:00 a.m. on the last Sunday in April ~~second Sunday in March~~ each year, official time for the village shall be advanced one hour. At 2:00 a.m. on the last Sunday in ~~October~~ **first Sunday of November** in each year such official time shall, by the retarding of one hour, be returned to Central Standard time

(B) All legal or official proceedings of the Board of Trustees and all official business of the village shall be regulated as to time in accordance with the provision of this section. When by ordinance, resolution, or action by any municipal officer or body, an act must be performed at or within a prescribed time, it shall be performed according to the official time as herein transcribed. When the words "Daylight Savings" or "Daylight Savings Time" are used in any official document or contract, it shall be understood to have reference to the time herein fixed for the period from the last Sunday

~~in April second Sunday in March until the last Sunday in October - first Sunday of~~
November.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
