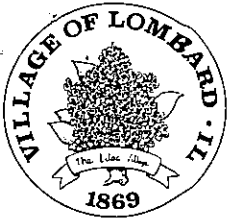

Subject: Award Bid #FS0610, one 2006 4x4 extended cab pick-up with plow

The FY 2006 budget includes replacement of FR080, a 1994 4x4 pick-up with plow. The bid results are as follows:

| Vendor | Bid Price | Less Trade-In | Net Total Bid |

| Northwest Ford Franklin Park, IL | 28,523 | 5,500 | 23,023 |
| Oakfield Ford Villa Park, IL | 27,265 | 4,200 | 23,065 |
| Ron Tirapelli Ford Shorewood, IL | 28,438 | 2,850 | 25,588 |
| Terry's Ford Peotone, IL | 28,998 | 3,100 | 25,898 |

Public Works received four sealed bids. Northwest Ford was low bidder. The bid price for the 2006 4x4 extended cab pick-up with plow is \$28,523 less a trade-in allowance of \$5,500 equals a net total bid of \$23,023. The budgeted amount is \$30,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to Northwest Ford of Franklin Park, IL. in an amount not to exceed \$23,023. I also recommend declaring village unit number FR080 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the September 1, 2005 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:

FR080 1994 Ford F-250 pick-up truck with plow VIN #1FTHF26H1RNB17287

now owned by the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, The Village routinely declares such type of personal property surplus and the best interest of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale and/or disposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interest of Lombard will be served by its sale/trade-in to Northwest Ford of Franklin Park, Illinois in the amount of \$5,500.00.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell and/or dispose of the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
