The Village received a request to correct the "No Parking" signs for the west side of North Garfield Street. There are two ordinances that covered the "No Parking" for the west side of Garfield Street. To correct the confusion and add some additional parking at the north end of Garfield Street the following changes will be needed:

At the April 7, 2008 Transportation and Safety Committee meeting, staff was directed to survey the affected business owners of the proposed change. On May 27, 2008, the attached survey and map were mailed. The results of the survey, tabulated today, revealed an overwhelming indifference to the proposed modification. Staff recommends modifying the North Garfield Street parking zones as presented.
