

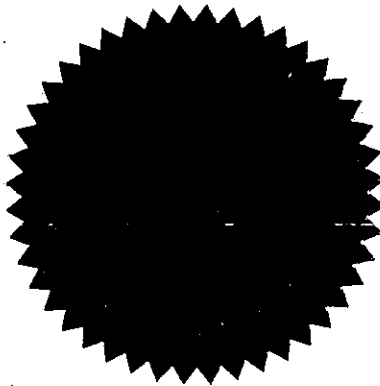

ORDINANCE NO. 4909

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a description for a new Class "Z" liquor license which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "Z" - Wine served for consumption on the premises of a wine and coffee café. Food service may be provided as an adjunct to the service of wine and coffee, however, no food preparation shall take place on the licensed premises. Package sales of wine shall be permitted."

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the list of authorized licenses to add a new class which shall read as follows:

"Class "Z" – 0"

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.14(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding an entry relative to a Class "Z" liquor license which shall read as follows:

"Class "Z" – \$500.00"

SECTION 4: Effective May 1, 2001, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "Z" liquor license to read as follows:

"Class "Z" – 1"

This increase in Class "Z" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "Z" liquor license, effective May 1, 2001, to Tasha's, Inc. d/b/a Tasha's Wine & Coffee Café located at 26 Shops of Yorktown, Lombard, Illinois.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




