Main St. The restaurant will be a full-service, family restaurant offering Italian cuisine with a service bar and outside seating. ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B I" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-I" - 8

This increase in Class "A/B-I" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B-I" liquor license to Nine Six 96 LLC who will be operating the business commonly known as Rosemary and Jeans located at 116 S. Main St., Lombard.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
