080738: Ordinance to Remove Parking Restriction on Michael McGuire Drive

The Transportation and Safety Committee voted to endorse an Ordinance modifying the restrictions on three (3) parking places on Michael McGuire Drive by removing the Municipal Parking Permit requirement and lessening the 10-minute limit restriction from 24 hours, 7 days per week to 5:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday.

<b>SCHEDULE XII - (a) PERMIT PARKING ZONES</b>
In accordance with Section 10-13-22, municipal parking permits may be issued authorizing the parking of private vehicle in the municipally owned or lease properties as follows.
<b>Delete:</b> St. Charles Road Commuter Lot and Park/Elizabeth Commuter Lot.
<b>Add:</b> St. Charles Road Commuter Lot and Park/Michael McGuire Drive (south side) Commuter Lot.

<b>SCHEDULE X - PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS</b>		
(s) In accordance with Section 10-13-10 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time exceeding ten (10) minutes, from 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays in any of the following places:		
<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>From</b>	<b>To</b>
Michael McGuire Drive, North curb	245 ft east of Lincoln Avenue eastern curb line	320 ft east of Lincoln Avenue eastern curb line.

To enhance usage for commuters, as well as provide additional after-hour downtown parking availability, removal of the Municipal Parking Permit requirement and limiting the 10-minute limit restriction to between 5:00 am and 6:00 pm Monday through Friday, were recommended by the Committee. These modifications require an ordinance to the Traffic Code as follows.

On February 2, 2009, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed three (3) parking spaces, located on the north side of Michael McGuire Drive, currently limiting parking to 10-minutes and requiring a valid Municipal Parking Permit between 5:00 am and 3:00 pm Monday through Friday, with free parking after 3:00 pm and all day Saturday, Sunday, and Holidays. An investigation of these parking locations, which consisted of visually inspecting the site on several days and at various times, revealed these parking spaces were not being effectively utilized. It appears afternoon drivers do queue in this general area to pick up commuters, but do not utilize the provided locations. This is likely due to the distance between the station platform and the parking locations, the need for a Municipal Parking Permit to use the spaces, and the limited 10-minute parking restriction at all times, even on weekends and holidays.

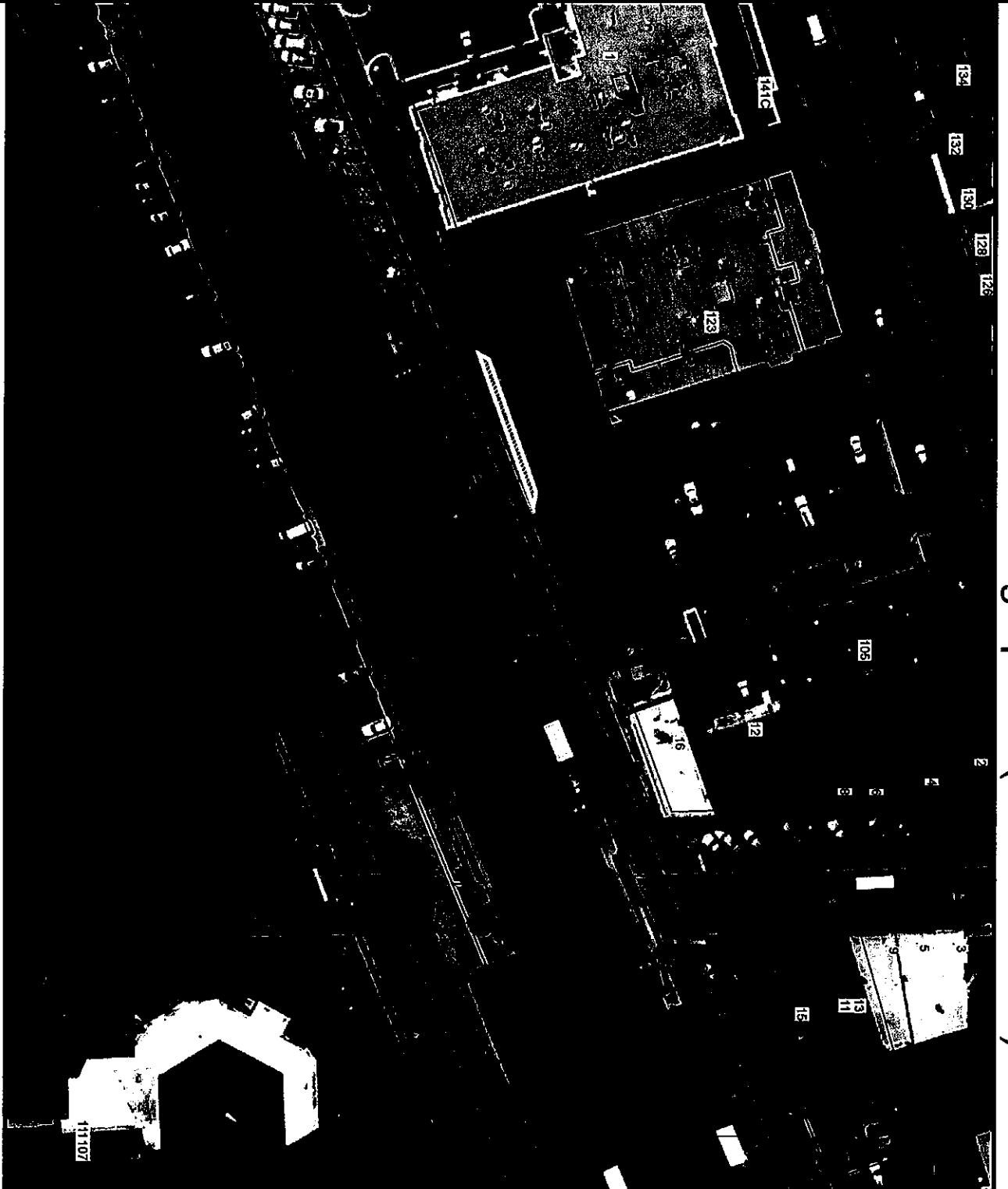

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE**

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule X of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

(S) In accordance with Section 10-13-10 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time exceeding ten (10) minutes between the hours of 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with the exception of holidays in any of the following places:
