Subject: FY12 Vehicle Joint Purchase

Included in the FY 2012 budget is the replacement for a Public Works Administration Division Ford Explorer (unit # UT94). This Ford Explorer will be retained by the Village and used to replace an older Taurus wagon in the Village Hall pool fleet (unit # VH16).

A Ford Escape will be purchased to replace the Ford Explorer. The Ford Escape is available for purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The current contract winner for the SPC is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The cost of the vehicle is \$18,909. The budgeted amount we have in reserve for this purchase is \$25,000.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$18,909 for one new Ford Escape. I also recommend declaring Village unit # VH16 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the April 7, 2011 meeting.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard to sell said personal property at public auction to be held weekly on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays in conjunction with the Tri-State Automobile Auction of Chicago. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and Board of Trustees find the following described property:

Unit #PI189 2003 Ford Taurus Sedan VIN #1FAFP53203G155357

now owned by the Village of Lombard is no longer necessary or useful to the Village of Lombard and the best interests of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale.

Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, at the Tri-State Automobile Auction grounds in Crestwood, Illinois to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.

Section 3: The Village Manager is hereby authorized and may direct the Tri-State Auction Service to advertise the sale of the aforementioned personal property in a newspaper published within the community before the date of said public auction.

Section 4: No bid which is less than the minimum price set forth in the list of property to be sold shall be accepted.

Section 5: The Village Manager or his designee shall cause to be transferred any titles or other legal documents pursuant to the sale.

Section 6: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval as provided by law.
