ORDINANCE NO. 8209

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SECTION 91.21(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO MEDICAL
TRANSPORTATION FEES FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS AND NONRESIDENTS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title IX, Chapter 91, Article II, Section 91.21(A) of the Lombard Village Code, is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(A) Fees are hereby imposed upon residents and nonresidents of the Village of Lombard using emergency medical service and/or emergency medical transportation service provided by the Village of Lombard at the following rates:

Resident Fees. As of January 1, 2024, the fees for emergency medical service and emergency medical transportation service charged to residents shall be the amounts determined by the annual report submitted for the previous year to the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services and/or the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services reflecting the actual costs incurred for transport of residents and nonresidents, discounted by ten percent (10%). The fees shall be increased annually thereafter, beginning on January 1, 2025 and without further action of the village board, based on the above-referenced annual report, discounted by ten percent (10%).

Nonresident Fees. As of January 1, 2024, the fees for emergency medical service and emergency medical transportation service charged to nonresidents shall be the amounts determined by the annual report submitted for the previous year to the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services and/or the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services reflecting the actual costs incurred for transport of residents and nonresidents. The fees shall be increased annually thereafter, beginning on January 1, 2025 and without further action of the village board, based on the above-referenced annual report."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on, from and after January 1, 2024 and the passage, approval and publication of this Ordinance in pamphlet form, as provided by law.




