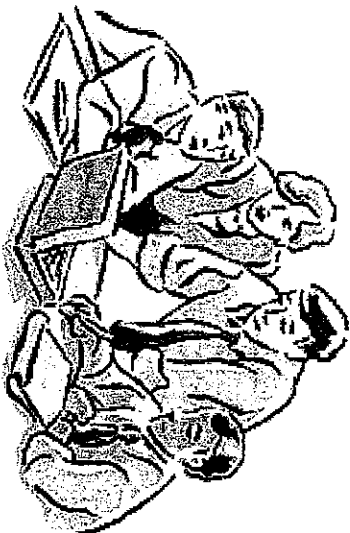

Chicago River Master Plan - Connecting People to the River

Chicago, Illinois, Illinois ASLA President's Award, 2003

As part of its "greening of the City" initiative, the City of Chicago is restoring and incorporating natural areas into the urban fabric with over 40,000 linear feet of the Chicago River shoreline, the parks along the Chicago River are some of the most notable opportunities to protect and restore the City's natural areas and to reconnect people with Chicago's natural origins. The Chicago River Master Plan guides naturalization efforts of the City's river parks and outlines an approach to reconnect people with Chicago's natural origins. The plan identifies over \$50 million in shoreline restoration and related development activities for 24 current and proposed CPD parks.

Kresge Foundation Headquarters

Troy, Michigan

The Kresge Foundation expanded their existing facilities to a 17,000 square foot headquarters on their currently occupied 3-acre site in Troy, Michigan. The new landscape is a series of naturalized plantings that evokes a stylized sense of the Midwestern prairie: an ornamental prairie garden along the entrance, a naturalized grass zone with grade that transitions into a green roof, a prairie landscape, and an aquatic wetland garden. Rainwater falls either onto planted surfaces or porous paving. Surplus water is collected and re-circulated, and will be used to compensate for evaporation in the aquatic water feature and to drip irrigate the green roofs.
