Design Engineering Contract Amendment #1

Attached please find a contract amendment in the amount of \$2,042.39 for Design Engineering associated with the Highland Avenue at Eastgate Road Traffic Signal Project. This contract amendment increases the upper limit of compensation for Civiltech Engineering, Inc. to \$25,298.39. Additional services associated with this amendment include an evaluation of the existing concrete pavement, the addition of audible pedestrian signals and attendance at the preconstruction meeting.

As detailed in the request from Civiltech, the additional work effort has an estimated cost of \$3,315.00, but as a result of being under budget on the total contract, the net contract amendment is \$2,049.39.

Please present this contract amendment to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on February 3, 2005. If approved, please have two signed copies returned to Engineering for further processing.

AGREEMENT TO AMEND A CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this <u>3rd</u> day of <u>February</u>, <u>2005</u>, by and between the **VILLAGE OF LOMBARD** (the "VILLAGE") and **CIVILTECH ENGINEERING**, **INC**. (the "CONSULTANT").

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2004 the VILLAGE and CONSULTANT executed a contract regarding certain engineering services relative to the <u>Highland Avenue at Eastgate Road Traffic Signals</u> projects; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE and CONSULTANT have agreed to increase the amount of work to be performed by the CONSULTANT together with a resultant increase in the limit which the contract sum may not exceed;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing and various covenants in said agreement and the mutual covenants herein contained, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

SECTION 1: The aforementioned contract shall be amended to expand the scope of work as provided for in the CONSULTANT'S January 18, 2005 letter.

SECTION 2: The aforementioned contract shall be amended to show a contract sum not to exceed \$25,298.39.

SECTION 3: All other terms, covenants and conditions of said contract heretofore executed which are not amended or deleted herein shall remain in full force and effect.



Justification for Supplement Fee Request:

Supplemental Work Items:

Item 1 - Concrete Pavement Reconstruction

At the request of the Village, Civiltech identified the limits of reconstruction of the existing concrete pavement which could potentially be included in the traffic signal installation contract. Civiltech prepared an exhibit highlighting this area and developed an estimate of construction cost.

Item 2 - Addition of Audible Pedestrian Signals (Addendum No. 1 to Bid Documents) Subsequent to the contract being advertised for bidding, the Village decided to add audible pedestrian signals to the proposed traffic signal installation. Civiltech's work for this item included research on current national design and operation standards for audible pedestrian signals, recommendation of an appropriate design and operation to the Village, and preparation of the Addendum which included plan revisions and preparation of a special provision. The use of audible pedestrian signals required modifications to the crosswalk across the south leg of the intersection and reconstruction of the median nose. This resulted in changes to the signal plan and median plan.

Item 3 – Pre-construction meeting

Civiltech has been requested to attend the pre-construction meeting. This item was not in our original contract.
