

**PROCLAMATION  
HONORING STATE REPRESENTATIVE BOB BIGGINS**

- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins was elected to the Illinois General Assembly as the Representative from the 41<sup>st</sup> District in 1993 and continues to serve in that capacity representing constituents including residents of the Village of Lombard; and
- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins has served on many committees including the Committee on Aging, the Tollway Oversight Committee, the Mass Transit Committee, and has served as minority spokesperson on both the General Services Appropriation Committee and the Revenue Committee; and
- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins has sponsored major legislation including Designation of the Official State Amphibian (tiger salamander) and Official State Reptile (painted turtle), and legislation regarding Identity Theft prosecution, and was instrumental in establishing Stroke Center Systems that initiated the existence of stroke trauma procedures and centers; and
- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins has always responded to the needs of the residents of the Village of Lombard and has responded to the Village's needs for funding from the State of Illinois for Village projects; and
- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins served as Addison Township Assessor from 1973–1979; served on the Board of Directors of the Suburban Bank of Elmhurst from 1975–1999, and served as Chairman of that Board from 1983–1984; and
- WHEREAS,** Bob Biggins was co-founder of Property Assessment Advisors, Incorporated and was involved in their operations from 1981-1993;
