FY09 Joint Purchase, Toyota Prius

Included in the FY09 budget is a replacement for Village unit # SM401, a 2002 Taurus wagon used by the Public Works Operations Superintendant. In an effort to save fuel staff considered buying a hybrid vehicle as a replacement. Though initially a hybrid cost more to purchase, it will cost less to operate over the life of the vehicle. Staff analyzed several vehicles and found the Toyota Prius was the best choice saving \$6,000 to \$8,000 over the life of the vehicle compared to a non-hybrid.

The Toyota Prius is available to local governments at a considerable discount through a joint purchasing program ran by the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The SPC is a group of 114 municipalities in a 6 county area of Northern Illinois. The SPC obtains contract pricing through the competitive bid process. The bid for this vehicle was published in the legal section of the Daily Herald on January 5, 2008 and was awarded through the sealed bid process to Arlington Toyota.

The SPC contract bid price for a new Toyota Prius is \$21,295. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$20,000. Though the initial purchase price is \$1,295 over budget the life cycle cost savings will more than offset the deficit.

I recommend waiver of bid and the award of a contract to Arlington Toyota of Buffalo Grove (IL) in the amount of \$21,295 for a new 2008 Toyota Prius. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the October 2, 2008 meeting.
