100550: Ordinance for Parking Restrictions On Elizabeth Street

The Village has received a request to consider extending the current parking restrictions on Elizabeth Street between Harrison and Harding. The Village has confirmed that as many as ten (10) to fourteen (14) vehicles are parked on both sides of Elizabeth Street between Harrison and Harding. Though sufficient room is available for emergency vehicles to pass between parked vehicles, Elizabeth Street is a more than average north-south traffic route. Utilization of less traveled streets in the area would be better suited for parking. Furthermore, the close proximity of the subject intersections of Elizabeth to Madison School promotes increased pedestrian traffic in the area.

On October 4, 2010, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend modifications to the Village Traffic Code. However, to insure the local residents were acceptable to the proposed modifications, a subsequent survey was mailed to each of the affected homeowners. Of the eighteen (18) surveys mailed, two (2) responses were received with one (1) concurring and one (1) negating the proposed modifications; thereby, supporting the Transportation and Safety Committee's following recommendations.

SCHEDULE VIII – PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS ON CERTAIN STREETS

(m) In accordance with Section 10-13-3 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle in any of the following places between the hours of 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. on school days on the following designated streets:
