AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, PROVIDING FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL IN CONNECTION WITH A SPECIAL EVENT AT 16 SOUTH PARK AVENUE

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (B)(6) thereto, effective upon the adoption of this Ordinance through 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 8, 2013, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"(6) In light of the fact that Bill and Punky's Step Up Inn., LTD., d/b/a Punky's Pub, located at 16 South Park Avenue, is holding a special event for the viewing of the BCS National Championship Game on January 7. 2013, said licensee shall be eligible for a Class "J" liquor license, despite the fact that said licensee is a for-profit business entity, for the sole purpose of selling alcoholic beverages for consumption in a designated and secured area adjacent to said licensed premises, to be approved by the Village pursuant to issuance of a special event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code, beginning at 4:00 p.m. on January 7, 2013 and terminating thirty (30) minutes after conclusion of the BCS National Championship game. The liquor license to be issued under this subsection (B)(6) may be issued by the Local Liquor Commissioner upon proper application to the Village and satisfaction of all applicable requirements and conditions by the licensee. No liquor license shall be issued under this subsection (B)(6) until such time as the licensee obtains the necessary special event permit under Chapter 110 of the Village Code and complies with all requirements and conditions thereof, including, without limitation, the insurance, bond and indemnification requirements of Chapter 110 for special events."

SECTION 2: That, effective at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 8, 2013, Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(B)(6) of the Lombard Village Code, as set forth in Section

1 above, is hereby repealed, without need for any further action by the President and
Board of Trustees.
SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage and approval as provided by law.
