Catch Basin Cleaning Bid

On April 6, 2007, six bids were received for the Catch Basin Cleaning project. This is a new project to supplement our annual catch basin cleaning program, which is currently performed solely by Village crews. The Village has a goal of cleaning onethird of the Village-owned catch basins each year. This program is one component of the Combined Sewer Overflow Operations & Maintenance Plan required by the IEPA Permit for the Lombard Combined Sewerage Treatment Plant to reduce sediment entering the treatment plant during rain storms.

The Catch Basin Cleaning project is budgeted in the Water & Sewer Capital Reserve Fund at a cost of \$30,000 for FY 06/07 and \$50,000 for FY 07/08. This bid extends over two fiscal years. Bids were received from the following companies:
