SUBJECT: Liquor Code Amendments

Please find attached an Ordinance revising the hours for purchasing alcohol on Sundays from noon to 10:00 a.m. for all liquor license holders. The surrounding communities have also changed their Sunday hours and concerns from local liquor license holders have brought this to my attention.

Also included in this Ordinance amendment is allowing grocery stores to sell alcohol through their main register aisles and not maintain a separate register for package liquor goods. The age requirement of twenty-one (21) remains the same for employees who participate in the retail sale of alcoholic liquor.

ORDINANCE
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112 OF THE
LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by repealing Section 112.35 in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Sections 112.36 (A) and (B) of the Lombard Village Code are amended to read in their entirety as follows:

“(A) Except as provided in subsections (B) and (C) below, it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale or to give away, in or upon any licensed premises, any alcoholic liquor between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday; between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday; and between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Sunday.

(B) In the case of a Class “M” liquor license, it shall be unlawful to remain open to the general public, or sell, offer for sale or to give away, in or upon the licensed premises, any alcoholic liquor between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday; and between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on Sunday.”

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
