The Illinois Department of Agriculture is requesting that all municipalities within the state agree to comply with the regulations set forth in an effort to control the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer. Although the insect has not been found in Lombard, it is recommended that in the event of an infestation, all municipalities and private tree care companies follow the same, standardized procedures to minimize the potential spread of this pest. The signing of this agreement prior to any infestation will ensure that the Village will comply with all regulations and expedite all control measures that are needed.
