Subject: FY25 Vehicle Replacement, Single Axle Dump Truck

The FY 2025 budget includes replacement of a 2013 International, single-axle dump truck, unit ST342. The replacement for ST342 will be equipped with a dump body, front plow and salt spreader. This truck is used for hauling large loads, plowing and salting operations. Large trucks such as this continue to be some of the most difficult vehicles to purchase due to the limited yearly production across all manufactures and high customer demand. Increasing emission mandates has only made matters worse and led to steep price increased as well. Current lead time to build this trucks is approximately 24 months. Staff is requesting Village Board authorization to place the order for the vehicles now for purchase in the FY25 budget.

Public Works has a standard set of specifications for these trucks which includes an International chassis outfitted with a Monroe dump body, salt spreader and plow. The International chassis is available for joint purchase through Sourcewell (formerly NJPA) contract #060920-NAV. The participating Sourcewell International dealer in our area is Rush Truck Centers. The dump body, plow and salt spreader are also available for joint purchase through the Sourcewell contract #062222-AEB. The participating Sourcewell vendor for this equipment is Monroe Equipment of Joliet, IL. The price of the Street Division truck outfitted with the above equipment is \$274,992.92 (\$123,286.92 chassis \$151,706.00 equipment). The amount in the 2025 budget for this purchase is \$270,000 with anticipated salvage value of \$30,000 for the disposal of the truck being replaced.

I recommend the Board of Trustees waive bid and award a contract to Rush Truck Centers of N Illinois and Monroe Truck Equipment in the amount of \$274,992.92 for a new International dump truck equipped per the Village specifications. I also recommend declaring Village unit number ST342, Vin #1HTWCAAR9DH416725, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing their sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the September 21, 2023 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:
