Attached please find the following items for Village Board consideration as part of the September 6, 2007 Village Board meeting:

- 1. A written recommendation from the Lombard Historical Commission recommending the designation of a portion of the property at 355 E. Parkside Avenue as a Landmark site.
- 2. The Notice of Landmark Site Designation by the President and Board of Trustees.
- 3. An Ordinance approving landmark site designation for the Sheldon Peck House and property at 355 E. Parkside Avenue.

The Historical Commission held a public meeting regarding this request on August 14, 2007 and made the recommendation set forth herein. They reviewed and approved the written recommendation at a special meeting on August 21, 2007. The Commission recommends that the entire property, except for the previously established 50-foot easement area at the north end of the property, be designated as a landmark site.

For reference purposes, staff has attached a copy of a draft plat of resubdivision depicting the subject property. The plat will make the lot a lot of record and will memorialize the previously executed easement agreement on the north side of the site.
