The FY 2008 budget includes replacement of unit number ST320, a 4x4 extended cab pickup with plow. The bid results are as follows:

Public Works received four sealed bids. Freeway Ford was the lowest bidder. The bid price for the new 4x4 extended cab pickup with plow is \$31,195 less a trade-in allowance of \$7,650 equals a net total bid of \$23,545. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$28,500.

I recommend the award of a contract to Freeway Ford of Lyons, Illinois in the amount of \$23,545. I also recommend declaring Village unit number EN439, a 1997 Ford 4x4 pickup with plow, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in.
