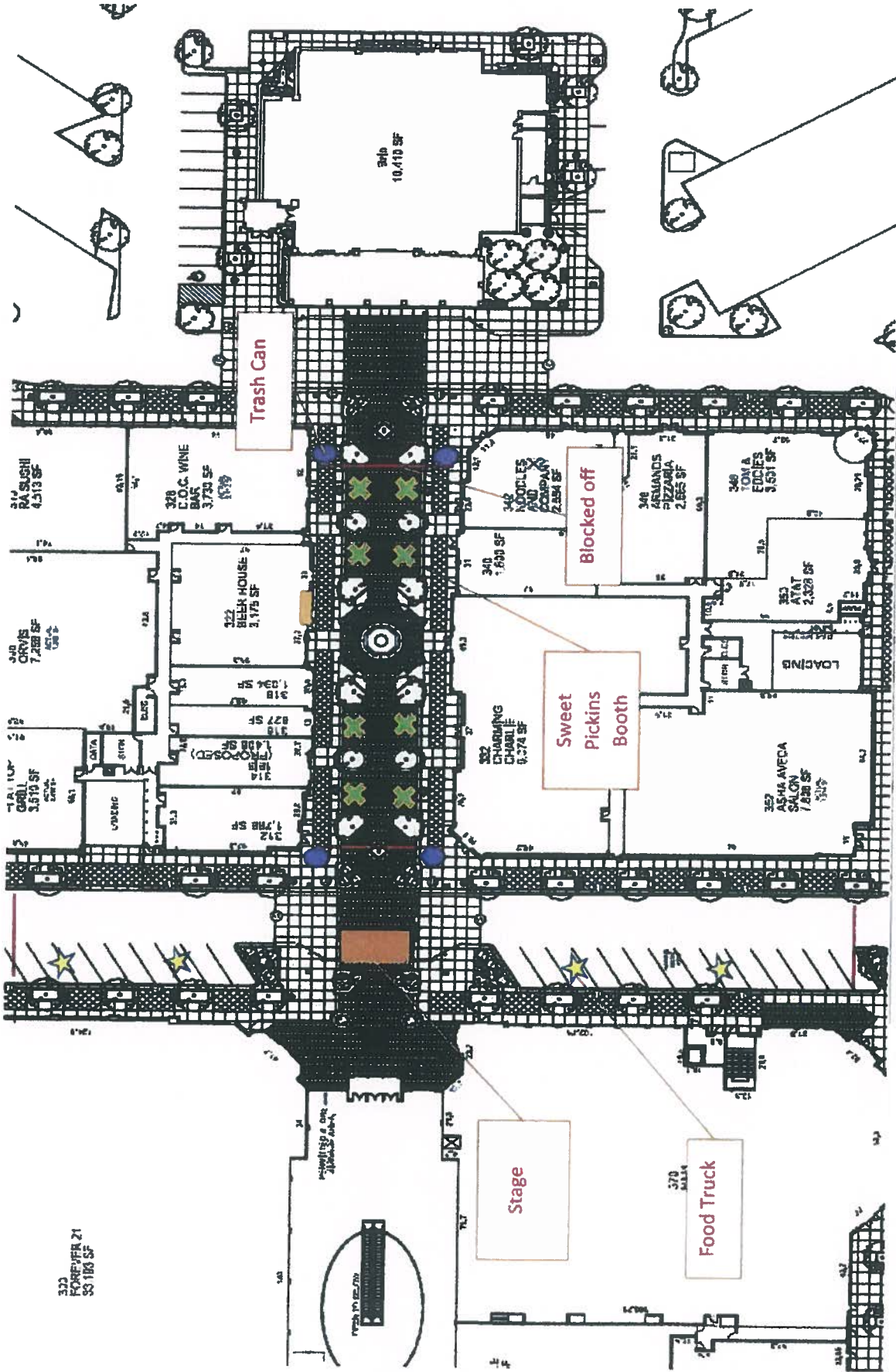
**SUBJECT:** **Yorktown Temporary Event – Summer Concert Series**
