### LEGAL NOTICE / PUBLIC NOTICE NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, Illinois will hold a public hearing on January 18, 2007 at its regular meeting at 7:30 p.m. in the Board Room of the Village Hall at 255 East Wilson Avenue, Lombard, Illinois 60148, pursuant to the requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, to consider the proposed issuance by the Village of Lombard, Illinois (the "issuer") of its Industrial Project Revenue Bonds (St. John's School Project), Series 2007 and Series 2008, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed Six Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,200,000) (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Congregation, U.A.C., Lombard, Illinois, an Illinois religious corporation (the "Borrower") to be used by the Borrower to: (i) finance or refinance the costs of construction of a two-story elementary school building to be located on the Borrower's site at 220 S. Lincoln Avenue, Lombard, Illinois; (ii) finance or refinance miscellaneous equipment, grounds, landscaping, renovation and site work at the Borrower's site at 215 - 220 S. Lincoln Avenue and 205 W. Maple Street, Lombard, Illinois (collectively, the "Project"); (iii) finance the payment of interest on the Bonds during construction and (iv) finance a portion of the costs of issuing the Bonds.

The Bonds will be issued pursuant to the Industrial Project Revenue Bond Act, 65 ILCS 5/1-74, et seq., as from time to time supplemented and amended (the "Act"). The Bonds and the obligation to pay principal and interest thereon shall not be deemed to constitute an indebtedness or a loan of credit of the Village of Lombard, the State of Illinois or any political subdivision thereof, or a charge against their general credit or taxing powers, within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory provision of the State of Illinois.

At the public hearing all persons will be afforded an opportunity to be heard in regard to the issuance of the Bonds and the location and nature of the Project. Written comments may also be submitted to the Village Clerk of the issuer at her office located at 255 East Wilson Avenue, Lombard, Illinois 60148, until January 16, 2007. Subsequent to the public hearing, at the regular meeting of the Village of Lombard, Illinois scheduled for January 18, 2007, the President and Board of Trustees shall consider final approval of the issuance of the Bonds.
