WHEREAS, the Private Engineering Services Division of the Village of Lombard has certified the completion of the public sanitary sewer, watermain and fire hydrants along East Greenfield Street (between Grace Street and LaLonde Avenue), and has recommended that said improvements be accepted; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities concur with said recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the public improvements, as certified by the Private Engineering Services Division and as set forth on the approved engineering plans for the public sanitary sewer, watermain and fire hydrants along East Greenfield Street (between Grace Street and LaLonde Avenue), be and hereby are accepted for ownership by the Village of Lombard.

SECTION 2: That the on-site sanitary sewer service and water service laterals are to remain the responsibility of the property owner(s).





**CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER,

We recommend acceptance by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard.

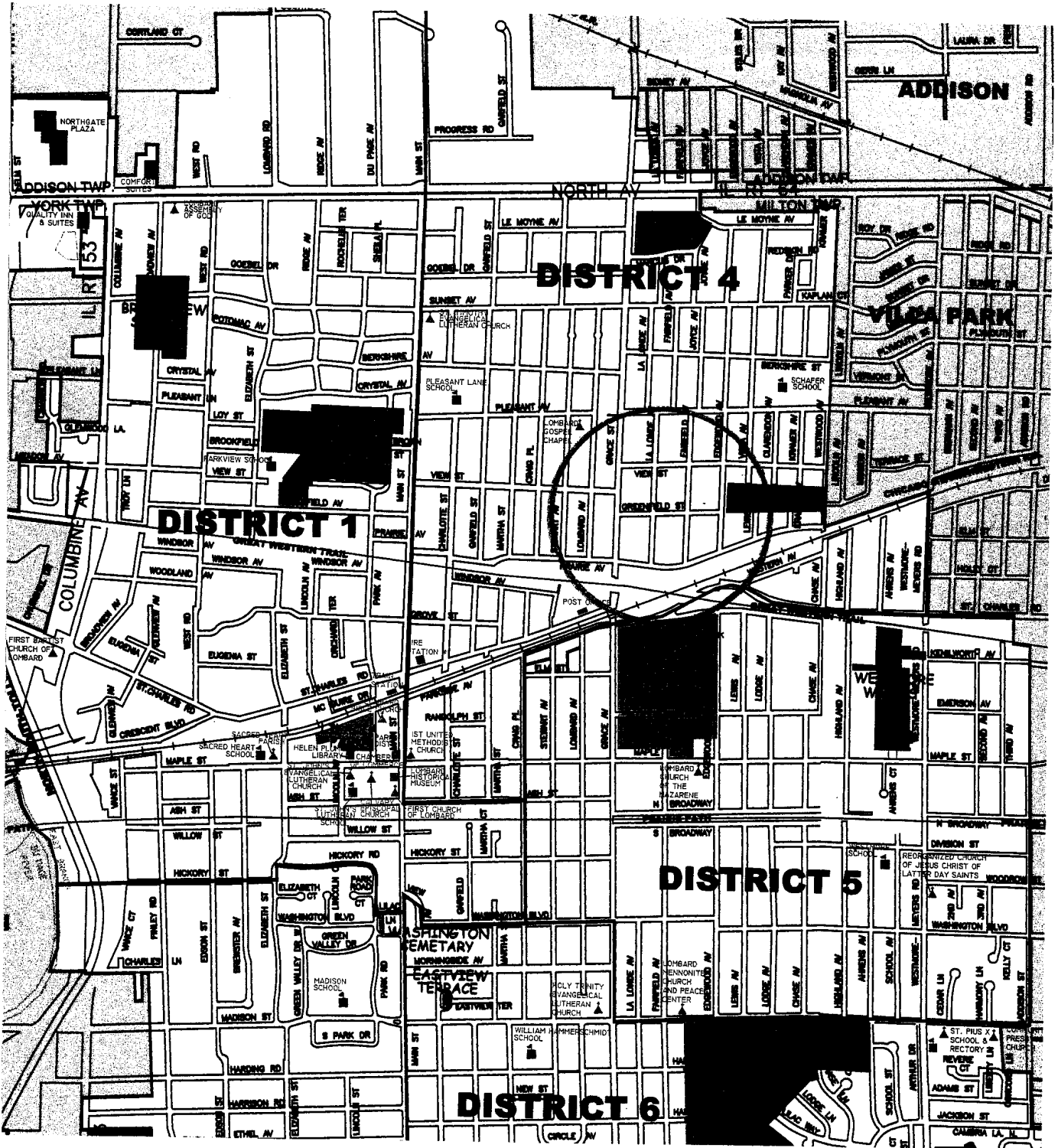

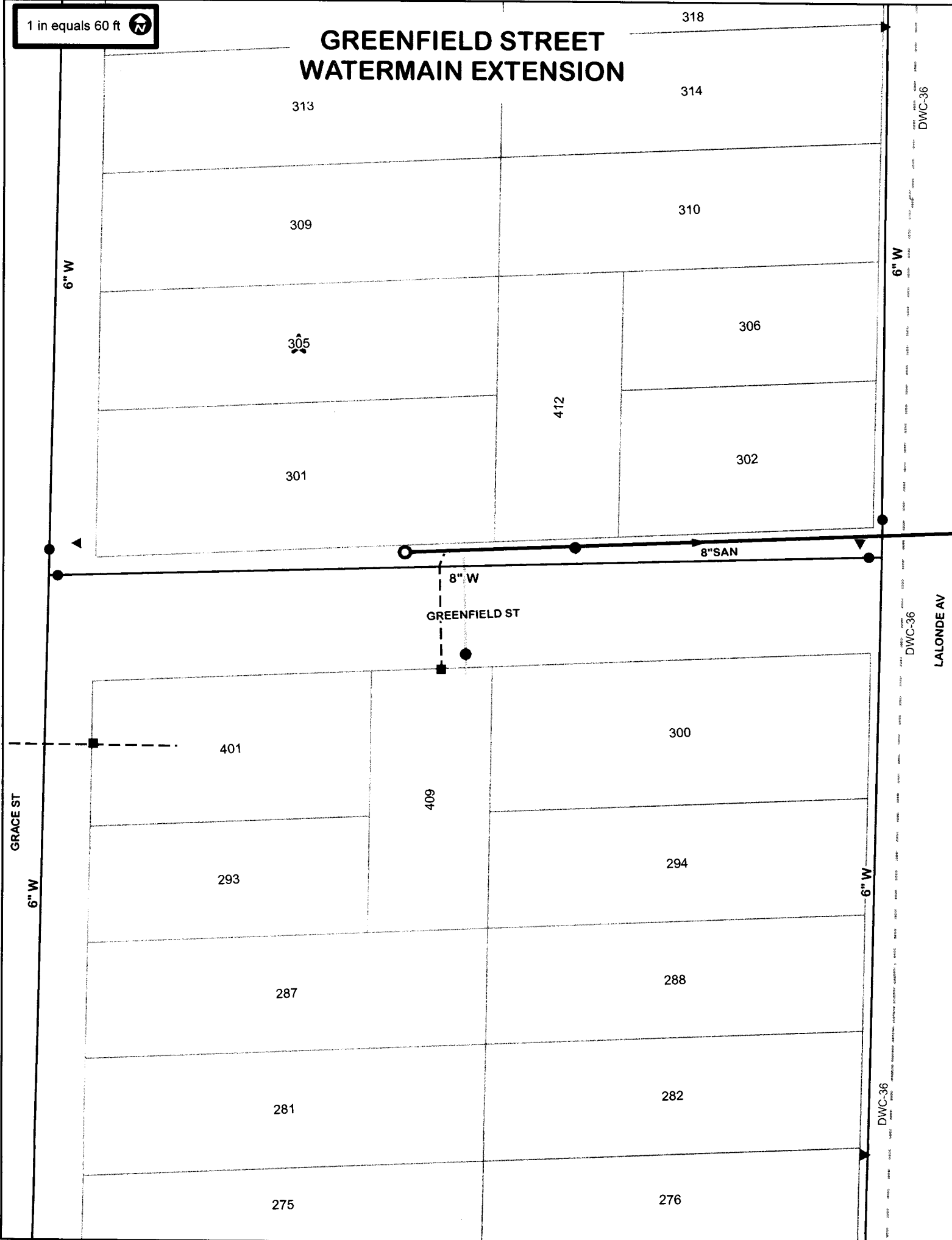
# GREENFIELD ST. WATER MAIN EXTENTION

**TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT**

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the "VILLAGE") has agreed to provide and install a decorative bicycle rack (hereinafter the "Bicycle Rack") at the northeast corner of the properties commonly known as 141 West St. Charles Road (P.I.N. 06-07-209-025) and 1 South Lincoln Avenue (P.I.N. 06-07-230-001 through 06-07-230-082) (hereinafter the "Subject Property"); and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Subject Property (hereinafter the "Owner") desires that the VILLAGE construct said Bicycle Rack and thereafter convey ownership of said Bicycle Rack to the Owner; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE needs a temporary easement over the Subject Property, at the location where the Bicycle Rack is to be installed, so as to be able to install the Bicycle Rack; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has agreed to install the Bicycle Rack at no cost to the Owner; and


WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has agreed to restore the Subject Property to its pre-construction condition after completing the installation of the Bicycle Rack;

NOW, THEREFORE, \_\_\_\_\_, as Owner of the Subject Property, hereby grants a temporary easement to the VILLAGE, and its officers, agents, employees and contractors, to facilitate the installation of the Bicycle Rack on the Subject Property, with title to said Bicycle Rack, upon completion thereof, to be transferred to Owner, by the VILLAGE, pursuant to a Bill of Sale, with the Owner being thereafter solely responsible for the maintenance and repair of said Bicycle Rack, as owner thereof. This temporary easement shall expire one (1) year from the latest date set forth below, or upon completion of the Bicycle Rack installation and transfer of title thereto to the Owner, pursuant to a Bill of Sale, whichever occurs first.

Section 2: That the Village Clerk be and hereby is authorized to attest said Temporary Construction Easement as attached hereto.




