Background

At the May 3, 2012 Village Board meeting, the Village approved Resolution R81-12 that authorized the execution of an IGA between the Village of Lombard and the Lombard Park District relative to the performance of maintenance tasks. The Park District approved the IGA on first reading at their April 24, 2012 meeting, but have since requested modifications to the IGA based upon the District's attorney review process. The Park District Board will consider this IGA under 2nd Reading at their June 26, 2012 meeting.

The Village has received redline copies of the IGA, but are awaiting final "clean" copies from the District, Upon receipt of the final documents, the IGA will be signed by the Village President and Village Clerk.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Village Board of Trustees approve the revised Intergovernmental Agreement between the Village of Lombard and the Lombard Park District regarding Maintenance Projects.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SIGNATURE OF PRESIDENT AND CLERK ON AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD AND THE LOMBARD PARK DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Village of Lombard approved a Resolution authorizing the Village President and Clerk to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the Lombard Park District regarding Maintenance Projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Lombard Park District requested modifications to the Agreement following the Village of Lombard approving the Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (hereinafter the "Agreement") with the Lombard Park District regarding Maintenance Projects; and,

WHEREAS, the Agreement has been drafted and a copy is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Rescinds Resolution 81-12.

SECTION 2: That the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is hereby approved.

SECTION 3: That the Village President be and hereby is authorized and directed to sign, on behalf of the Village of Lombard, the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 4: That the Village Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to sign, on the behalf of the Village of Lombard, the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made part hereof.

Dear Charlene:

After reviewing the three (3) revised Intergovernmental Agreements, that you forwarded to me on May 16, 2012, with Village staff, I have the following comments:

- 1. <u>SHOWMOBILE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT</u> The revisions are acceptable.
- 2. <u>DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS/DRINKING FOUNTAIN MAINTENANCE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT</u> The revisions are acceptable.
- 3. TERRACE VIEW POND INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT -
 - A. <u>Second Whereas Clause:</u> While the wording in the quote may not make sense, it is verbatim from the Resolution executed by the Village and the Park District, dated March 6, 1972.
 - B. <u>Fifth Whereas Clause</u>, <u>Subsection C.ii.</u>: This provision should be revised to read as follows, as the plans and permits are based on the pump location called out in the preliminary design review.
 - " ii. Phase Two shall include the installation of a pump station on the Park Property at the location set forth in the preliminary design review presented to the Park District Commissioners on October 25, 2011, to lower the normal water level of the Pond by one (1) foot: and "

C. Section 2.B.:

- i) The Exhibit reference should be to "Exhibit B."
- ii) So that there is nothing left to work out, do you have an easement agreement format, that you and the Park District are comfortable with, that can be attached as an Exhibit? If not, I can provide the format used by the Village.
- iii) While past discussions between the Village and Park District staffs were in regard to a blanket easement, Village staff will have Christopher B. Burke Engineering Ltd. prepare a legal description for a more limited area of the Park Property.

Based on the foregoing, this Section should be revised to read as follows:

"B. Grant a permanent stormwater management easement to the VILLAGE over the portion of the Park Property described and depicted in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made part hereof, pursuant to the terms of the easement agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and made part hereof."

D. Section 2.D.:

- i) The Exhibit reference should be revised based on the comments in C. above.
- ii) Same comment as in C. ii) above relative to the easement agreement.

Based on the foregoing, this Section should be revised to read as follows:

"D. Accept title to the property acquired by the VILLAGE, along West Crystal Avenue, (said property being legally described on Exhibit "D" attached hereto and made part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "West Crystal Parcel")), for the purposes of constructing the PROJECT, upon completion of the PROJECT, subject to the VILLAGE's retention of a permanent stormwater management easement over said property pursuant to the terms of the easement agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "C", and subject to the VILLAGE's obligations, as set forth below, with respect to the West Crystal Parcel;"

- E. Section 2.E.: This Section should be revised to read as follows:
 - "E. Assume all costs of maintenance and repairs to the West Crystal Parcel upon conveyance of title thereto to the DISTRICT, with the exception of the underground relief sewer pipes installed by the VILLAGE, in connection with the PROJECT, which shall be maintained by the VILLAGE as provided below."
- F. <u>Section 2.F.:</u> The parenthetical phrase in this Section should be replaced with the following:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing, except for the underground relief sewer pipes, the DISTRICT shall, at its sole cost and expense, maintain the West Crystal Parcel, including, but not limited to, the asphalt path referred to in E. above."

- **G. Section 2.G.:** This Section should be revised to read as follows:
 - "G. Be solely responsible for any and all adverse impacts on the Park Property or the surrounding properties reasonably related to or arising from the construction and/or operation of the PROJECT."

AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD AND THE LOMBARD PARK DISTRICT

THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2012, by and between the VILLAGE OF LOMBARD (hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE") and the LOMBARD PARK DISTRICT (hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT"). The VILLAGE and the DISTRICT are hereinafter sometimes individually referred to as a "Party" and collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and 5 ILCS 220/1, et seq. authorize units of local government to contract or otherwise associate among themselves to obtain or share services, to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function, in any manner not prohibited by law, to use their credit, revenues and other reserves to pay costs and to service debt related to intergovernmental activities; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT desires to make improvements to the drainage at the Lombard Community Building located at 433 East St. Charles Road, Lombard, Illinois, (hereinafter referred to as the "Project Location"), including the installation of two (2) four (4) foot diameter storm basins and related piping, in front of the entrance to the DISTRICT'S water park, to drain two (2) low areas on each side of the grassed island, with the VILLAGE needing to install two (2) structures on the main storm sewer line to intercept these new basin lines, all as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "PROJECT"); and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE is responsible for the repair and maintenance of drinking fountains at the following locations:

The Illinois Prairie Path and Main Street;

The Illinois Prairie Path and Grace Street;

The Illinois Prairie Path and Westmore/Meyers Road;

The Great Western Trail and Main Street; and

The Great Western Trail and Westmore/Meyers Road;

(hereinafter the "Maintenance Locations"), with said repair and maintenance consisting of the items set forth on Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made part hereof (hereinafter referred to as the "MAINTENANCE"); and [SEE NOTE ON EXHIBITE]

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT that the Parties undertake the PROJECT and the MAINTENANCE; and

WHEREAS, the VILLAGE has agreed to proceed with the design and construction of the PROJECT, at its sole cost and expense, (other than as specified below), provided the DISTRICT supplies all the materials associated with required to be used in the construction of the PROJECT, and performs all necessary landscape restoration work relative to following completion of construction of the PROJECT, and further provided the DISTRICT performs the MAINTENANCE at the Maintenance Locations for a period of three (3) years, at the DISTRICT'S sole cost and expense; and

WHEREAS, the DISTRICT has agreed to perform the MAINTENANCE at the Maintenance Locations, as specified in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and made part hereof, at its sole cost and expense, for a period of three (3) years from the date of this AGREEMENT, provided the VILLAGE proceeds with the PROJECT as set forth above, and provided the VILLAGE, at its sole cost and expense, provides the DISTRICT with all necessary parts to do so; and

WHEREAS, the Parties have determined that the VILLAGE can more cost effectively undertake the PROJECT, and that the DISTRICT can more cost effectively perform the MAINTENANCE over the next three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the VILLAGE and the DISTRICT to enter into this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the mutual covenants and agreements contained therein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by the Parties, the Parties hereto-agree as follows:

- 1. <u>INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLES.</u> The preambles hereto, as set forth above, are incorporated herein by reference and are made part hereof.
- 2. <u>VILLAGE OBLIGATIONS.</u> In relation to the PROJECT and the MAINTENANCE, the VILLAGE agrees to:

 - B. Provide all the necessary parts to the DISTRICT, for the MAINTENANCE at the Maintenance Locations, at the VILLAGE'S sole cost and expense.
- 3. <u>DISTRICT OBLIGATIONS.</u> In relation to the PROJECT and the MAINTENANCE, the DISTRICT agrees to:

- A. Supply the VILLAGE with all materials relative to required to be used in the construction of the PROJECT, at the DISTRICT'S sole cost and expense;
- B. Perform all <u>landscape</u> restoration work, <u>relative tofollowing completion of the construction of</u> the PROJECT, at its sole cost and expense; and
- C. Perform the MAINTENANCE at the Maintenance Locations, at its sole cost and expense, subject to the VILLAGE providing the DISTRICT with the parts therefor, at the VILLAGE'S sole cost and expense, for a period of three (3) years from the date of this Agreement.
- 4. <u>CONSTRUCTION RIGHT OF ENTRY.</u> The DISTRICT hereby grants to the VILLAGE, and the VILLAGE'S officers, agents, employees, consultants and contractors, the right to enter upon the Project Location for the purpose of surveying, engineering, designing and constructing the PROJECT.
- 5. <u>DISTRICT INDEMNIFICATION OF THE VILLAGE</u>. The DISTRICT shall indemnify and hold harmless the VILLAGE, and its elected <u>and appointed officials</u>, officers, agents and employees, with respect to any claim or loss, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees, costs and expenses of litigation, claims and judgments in connection with any and all claims for damages of any kind to the extent which maythey arise, either directly or indirectly, out of the acts or omissions of the DISTRICT, or its elected officials, officers, agents, employees, consultants or contractors, pursuant to this Agreement.
- 6. VILLAGE INDEMNIFICATION OF THE DISTRICT. The VILLAGE shall indemnify and hold harmless the DISTRICT, and its elected officials, officers, agents and employees, with respect to any claim or loss, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees, costs and expenses of litigation, claims and judgments in connection with any and all claims for damages of any kind to the extent they which may arise, either directly or indirectly, out of the acts or omissions of the VILLAGE, or its elected or appointed officials, officers, agents, employees, consultants or contractors, pursuant to this Agreement.
- 7. Notice or other writings which either Party is required to, or may wish to, serve upon the other Party in connection with this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally or sent by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

A. If to the VILLAGE:

or to such other address, or additional parties, as either Party may from time to time designate in a written notice to the other Party. Service by certified mail shall be deemed given on the third day following the mailing of said notice, and service by personal delivery shall be deemed given upon actual delivery.

- 8. <u>COUNTERPARTS.</u> This Agreement shall be executed simultaneously in two (2) counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same Agreement.
- 9. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or written or oral agreements between them regarding the within subject matter. There are no representations, agreements, arrangements or understandings, oral or written, between and among the Parties hereto relating to the subject matter of this Agreement which are not fully expressed herein.
- 10. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE.</u> This Agreement shall be deemed dated and become effective on the date on which the last of the Parties executes this Agreement as set forth below.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the VILLAGE, pursuant to authority granted by the adoption of a [Motion/Resolution] by its Board of Trustees, has caused this Agreement to be executed by its President and attested by its Clerk; and the DISTRICT, pursuant to authority granted by the adoption of a [Motion/Resolution] by its Board of Park Commissioners, has caused this Agreement to be signed by its President and attested by its Secretary.
