The FY 2008 budget includes replacement of ST378, a 2001 Elgin Pelican street sweeper. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Standard Equipment Chicago, IL	154,741	30,000	124,741

Public Works received one sealed bid from Standard Equipment Company. The bid price for the new street sweeper is \$154,741 less a trade-in allowance of \$30,000 equals a net total bid of \$124,741. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$140,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to the only bidder, Standard Equipment Company of Chicago Illinois, in the amount of \$124,741.
