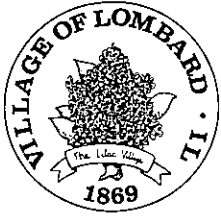

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The FY 2008 budget includes replacement of ST378, a 2001 Elgin Pelican street sweeper. The bid results are as follows:

Vendor	Bid Price	Less Trade-In	Net Total Bid
Standard Equipment Chicago, IL	154,741	30,000	124,741

Public Works received one sealed bid from Standard Equipment Company. The bid price for the new street sweeper is \$154,741 less a trade-in allowance of \$30,000 equals a net total bid of \$124,741. The budgeted amount for this vehicle is \$140,000.

I recommend the award of a contract to the only bidder, Standard Equipment Company of Chicago Illinois, in the amount of \$124,741. I also recommend declaring Village unit number ST378, a 2001 Elgin Pelican street sweeper, as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the April 19, 2007 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL  
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:

Unit #ST378 a 2001 Elgin Pelican street sweeper. VIN #P3510D

now owned by the Village of Lombard; and

WHEREAS, The Village routinely declares such type of personal property surplus and the best interest of the Village of Lombard will be served by its sale and/or disposal.
