Description

The purpose of this yearly maintenance program is to eliminate cracks, fractures, and holes in sewer pipes. Lining improves the structural integrity of the pipe by preventing catastrophic failures and improves the operation of the pipe along with reducing routine maintenance.

Cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) is a jointless, seamless, flexible plastic pipe liner that is installed within an existing pipe. The process involves the insertion of an uncured tube of resin into the existing, defective pipe. Hot air and/or water or ultraviolet light are used, expanding and hardening (curing) the tube creating a liner to fit against the wall of the pipe, essentially creating a pipe within a pipe. Being a “trenchless” technology, CIPP lining minimizes disruptions typically associated with construction which benefits property owners and the motoring public.

Bidding Process

Considering the CIP budget and the scope of this year's contract, it was decided to send proposals to 7 sewer lining specialty contractors. Proposals were sent out via QuestCDN an online bidding service that the Public Works – Engineering Division routinely utilizes.

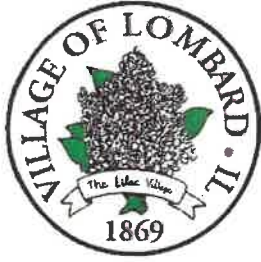

Village of Lombard Contract Sanitary Sewer Lining Program (FY 24)

RM PROG 11 (FY 24)

This agreement is made this 15th day of February 2024, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and _____ (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as outlined in the Request for Proposal:

PWS (Performance Work Statement), Cleaning And Televising -Sanitary 8", 10" & 15", Heavy Cleaning Sanitary 8", 10" & 15", Sanitary Sewer Lining 8", 10" & 15" Reinstatement Of Service Connections, Post Lining Televising 8", 10", & 15" And Maintenance Of Traffic as stated in the proposal schedule for a total cost of \$87,676.00

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
 - a. Contract Document Number RM PROG 11 (FY 24) for the Sanitary Sewer Lining Program (FY 24), consisting of the following:
 - i) Cover Sheet
 - ii) Table of Contents
 - iii) General Provisions
 - iv) Special Provisions
 - v) Appendices A- F
 - b. The Contractor's Proposal Dated: February 5, 2024
 - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
 - d. Persons and Entities Subject to Disqualification
 - e. Proposer's Certification Form
 - e. Anti-Collusion Affidavit
 - f. Conflict Of Interest
 - g. Tax Compliance Affidavit
 - h. Subcontractor Identification
2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown in the Contractor's Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete all work under this Contract by December 13, 2024. Time is of the essence regarding this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.

4. Under the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, before making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment, nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
