SUBJECT: **Text Amendment to Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A)**
Number of Authorized Liquor Licenses – Class “A/B-III”
Brio Tuscan Grille – 330 Yorktown

FoodFirst Global Restaurants, Inc. d/b/a Brio Tuscan Grille located at 330 Yorktown currently holds a Class “A/B-III” liquor license which allows them to serve alcohol as an adjunct to food service with no packaged sales. On June 17, 2021 staff received a letter indicating that the establishment is permanently closed and requested that their liquor license be terminated.

In response to that request as well as a result of their liquor license expiring on June 30, 2021, attached is an ordinance decreasing the Class “A/B-III” liquor license category by one as required by Village Code.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to bring the number of licenses available in the Class “A/B-III” liquor classification current to reflect this change.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13(A) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 11

That the decrease in the number of Class "A/B-III" liquor licenses as set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of FoodFirst Global Restaurants, Inc. d/b/a Brio Tuscan Grille located at 330 Yorktown, no longer conducting business.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
