The Environmental Concerns Committee recommended approval of four Recycling Education Grant applications at their October 26, 2010 meeting. The recommendations are as follows:

Glenbard East High School           \$350.00  
*For native prairie plant plugs to be used in a restoration project.*

Glenn Westlake Middle School       \$620.00  
*For recycling containers. (The ECC reduced the amount from the School's request of \$714.)*

Manor Hill Elementary School       \$340.00  
*For 20 books entitled "This Tree Counts". (The ECC reduced the amount from the School's request of \$4,460.)*

Pleasant lane Elementary School    \$650.00  
*For a musical theater assembly featuring earth science songs.*

TOTAL =   \$1,960.00
