Subject: Tree Consortium Bid waiver

On August 4, 1988, the Village Board approved participation in the Suburban Tree Consortium. Representing 42 member communities, this organization handles the tree planting bid process in accordance with State of Illinois law. As a member, the Village must commit to a lead-time of five years for the purchase of trees grown based upon projected orders for trees.

\$75,000.00 is currently budgeted for parkway tree planting for FY15. This figure represents approximately 250 trees that will be planted in the Spring & Fall of 2015 planting seasons. As a formality, the Village Attorney has recommended waiving bids and approval of this payment.

On March 18, 1999, the Village Board approved the planting of parkway trees through the Consortium on *Capital Improvement Projects* as part of projects in the CIP budget. Beginning with FY12B, the CIP included funds for the removal and replacement of parkway trees lost to the emerald ash borer. It is anticipated that \$51,077.00 from the CIP will be allocated for tree planting in 2015 for an additional 170 trees.

Additional trees are planned to be planted along the Great Western Trail bridge for screening (\$7,500.00 – 20 trees), to replace trees removed in Phase I of the Lombard Meadows street reconstruction (\$8,400.00 – 24 trees), and an estimated 15 trees from funds collected by Community Development fees (\$4,500.00).

The Suburban Tree Consortium provides top quality trees grown specifically for parkway conditions. We have received a superior product in the past and recommend waiver of bids in an amount not to exceed \$146,477.00 for trees from the Suburban Tree Consortium for FY15.
