The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public sanitary sewer, watermain and fire hydrants along East Greenfield Street (between Grace Street and Lalonde Avenue). The stated improvements are acceptable since they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests. 






We recommend acceptance by the Village President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard.

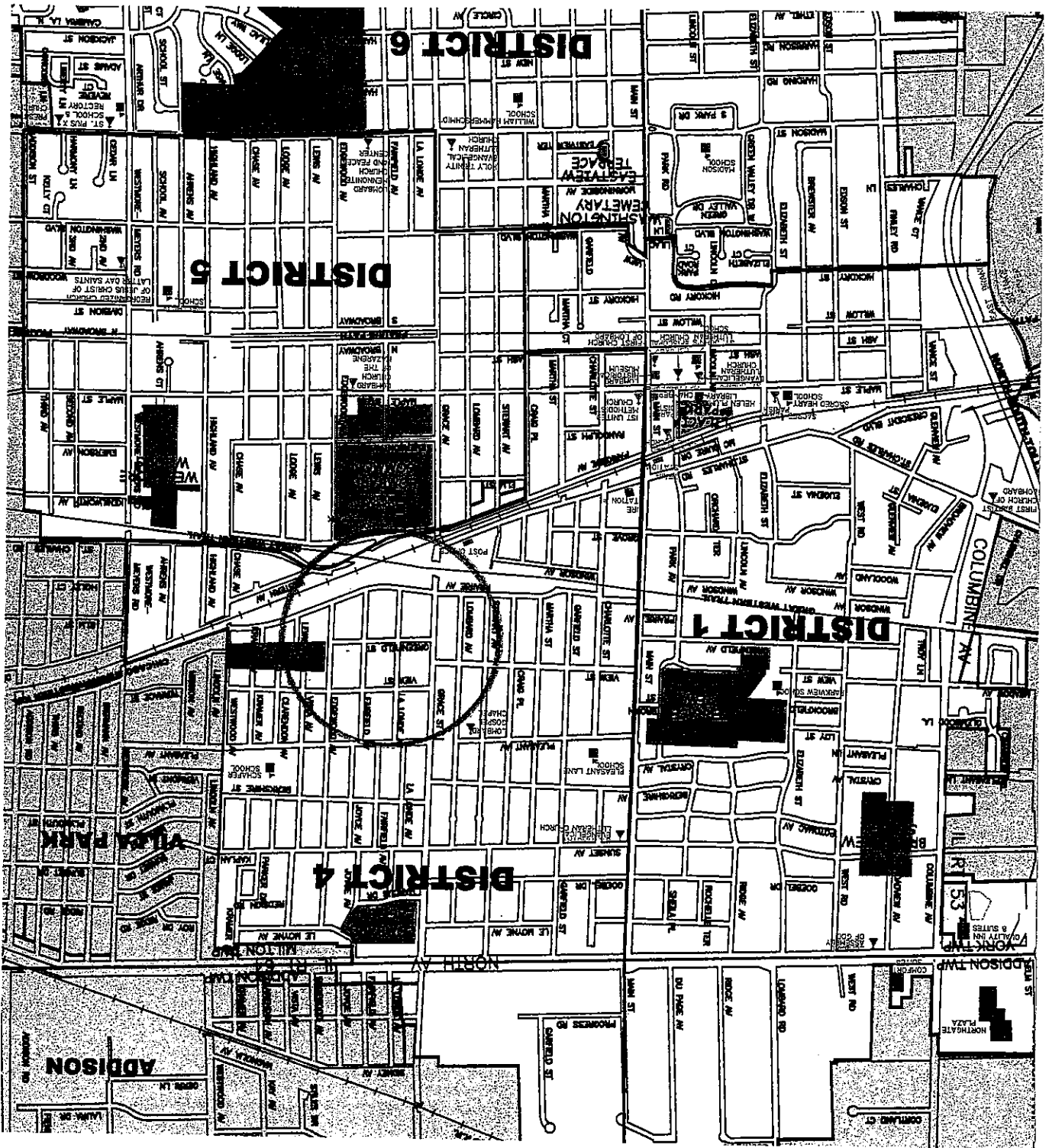

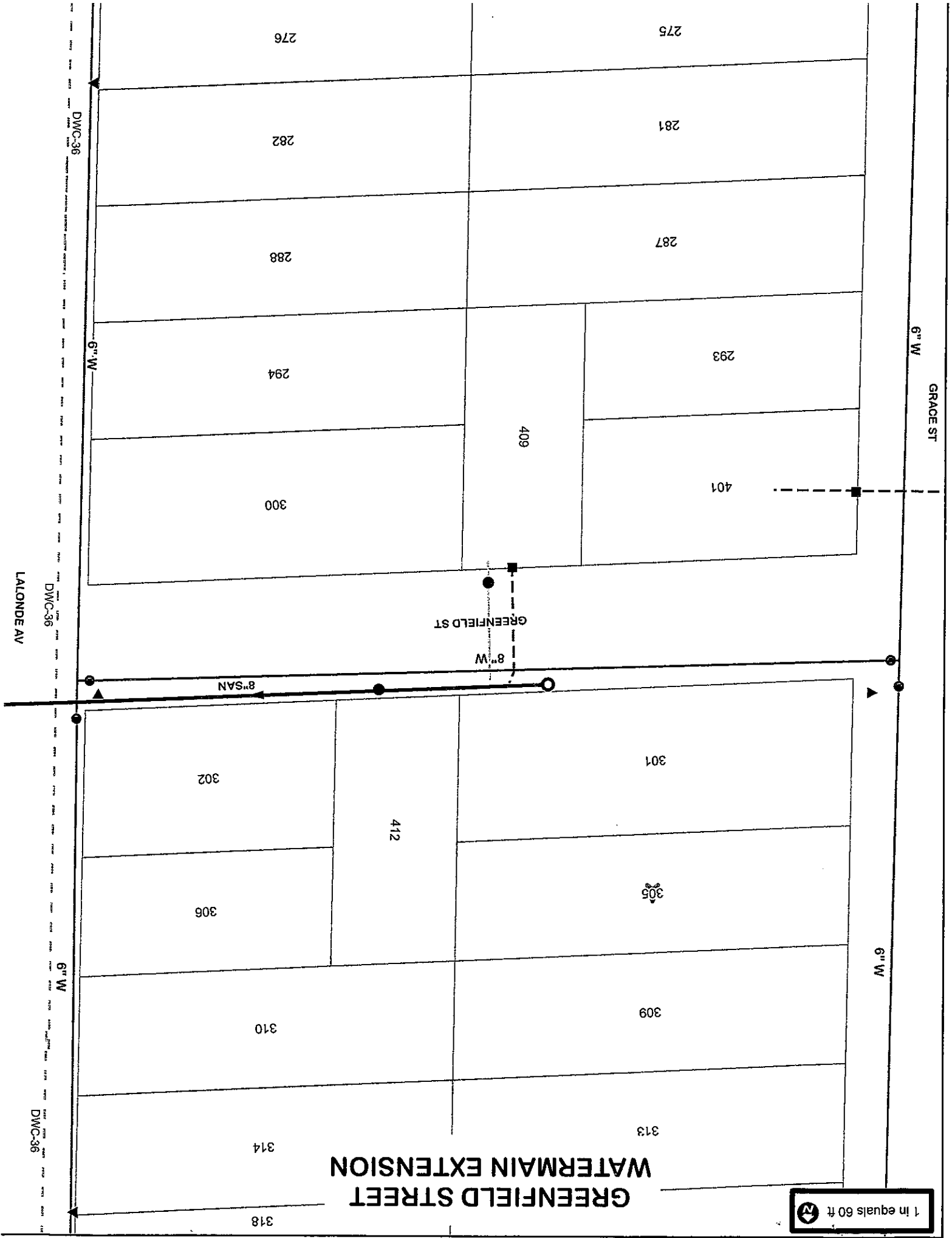
