development) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, amend the Yorktown Peripheral Planned Development, as established by Ordinance No. 3962, and any companion zoning approvals, as follows:

1. A change to the geographical extent of the previously approved planned development and any companion zoning approvals; and

Pursuant to Section 155.502 (F) (3) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, approve a conditional use for a planned development with the following companion deviations, use exceptions, and variations:

- Deviations and variations from the B3 Community Shopping

 (F), (G), (H), (I), (J), and (K) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, to

- 3. A variation from Section 155.508 (B)(3) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance to allow for use exceptions, ground-floor residential dwelling units, for more than forty percent (40%) of the site area or more than forty percent (40%) of the total floor area, whichever is less;
- A variation from Section 155.707 to waive transitional landscape yard requirements where residential uses are proposed in the B3 zoning district; and
- 5. A variation from the Planned Development Standards, Article IX of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, to establish the process for administration of the Yorktown Commons Planned Development as forth in Section IV of the "Yorktown Commons Planned Development Design Guidelines" and granting site plan approval authority to the Plan Commission, pursuant to Section 155.511 of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance.
