- 5. A variation from the Planned Development Standards, Article IX of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance, to establish the process for administration of the Yorktown Commons Planned Development as forth in Section IV of the "Yorktown Commons Planned Development Design Guidelines" and granting site plan
