Highlights in Downtown Lombard:

- Jinglebell Jubilee went very well this year with hundreds of people stopping in downtown Lombard to see the dancers in the storefront windows
- Lombard Town Centre did little promotion for Small Business Saturday as our time was focused on our annual report and funding for 2016.
- Cyber Monday was very busy for some downtown businesses
- A tobacco shop has leased the empty Bona Pizza at 6 W. St. Charles
- The Cellar and Fringe have both hosted events at their businesses. This shows the commitment of the businesses in the community.
- MWD Photography has opened at 108 E. St. Charles Rd. This business moved from downtown Elmhurst. They have extra space in the building they purchased for potential lease.
- 104 - 106 E. St. Charles Rd. went up for auction on December 4, 2015. No buyers at that.
