The Transportation and Safety Committee voted to endorse an Ordinance to restrict parking in the vicinity of Oak Creek and Springer Drives to mitigate an increase in pedestrian and traffic congestion.

In accordance with Section 10-13-6 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall, at any time, park a vehicle upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

ADD: Oak Creek Drive, North Side	I-355 Right-of-Way	A point 60 feet east of the Springer Drive eastern curb line.
ADD: Springer Drive, East and West Sides	Oak Creek Drive	The southern curb line of Lloyd Avenue.
ADD: Lloyd Avenue, West Side	Springer Drive	A point 55 feet west of the Springer Drive western curb line.

SCHEDULE VII - PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS

On August 3, 2009, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed traffic congestion and pedestrian safety concerns currently affecting the Oak Creek and Springer Drives area. Vehicles park on both sides of Oak Creek Drive and along portions of Lloyd Avenue and Springer Drive throughout the work week limiting driver visibility around the curved section of the road and at intersections. The posted speed limit of 30 mph coupled with the presence of joggers, a high traffic volume from Foxworth Boulevard, and employees entering and leaving the roadway create a congested area of concern. Several options were discussed, such as taking no action, increasing enforcement of existing parking regulations, reducing the speed limit (after traffic analysis data supports a reduction), striping the road to better delineate traffic and parking stalls, or prohibiting parking. The Committee voted to recommend stepping up enforcement of existing traffic regulations and implementing No Parking Zones on the northern side of Oak Creek Drive from I-355 continuously to the first driveway of the property located at 1000 Lloyd Avenue and along the northeast corner of Springer Drive. This action requires an ordinance to the Traffic Code as follows.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE

ORDINANCE NO. _____

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

Name of Street	From	To
Oak Creek Drive	I-355 r-o-w	A point 60 feet east of the Springer Dr. Eastern curb line
Springer Drive,	Oak Creek Drive	Southern curb line of Lloyd Ave.
Lloyd Ave.	Springer Drive	a point 55 feet west of the Springer Dr. Western curb line

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
