2009 Concrete Rehab and Utility Cuts Patching

The proposed FY 2008-2009 CIP includes a Concrete Rehab and Utility Cuts Patching project in the estimated amount of \$900,000 with \$600,000 being funded under capital projects and the remaining \$300,000 from the Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) Fund. In accordance with State requirements, a resolution must be approved for allocating the MFT funding for this project.

Attached for your consideration are four (4) original "Resolution for Improvement by Municipality Under the Illinois Highway Code" stating the Village's appropriation of \$300,000.00 of Motor Fuel Tax funds. Staff recommends approval.
