BACKGROUND

The Lombard Jaycees have recently submitted an application to post signage for their annual White Cane Days event to be held between April 19, 2012 and April 21, 2012. As part of their request, the Lombard Jaycees are requesting approval of the use of public right-of-way for temporary banner signs. The specific location of the signs would be at the southeast comer of Main Street and Wilson Avenue

The sign would be 32 square feet in area. The sign would be placed at the specified locations on or around April 8, 2012 and would be removed following the conclusion of their event.
