SUBJECT: Signage Associated with Sacred Heart Germanfest

BACKGROUND
Sacred Heart Parish will be hosting its annual Germanfest July 19th through July 22nd. They are requesting approval from the Village Board for the use of public right-of-way for temporary directional signage. Section 153.103(B)(6) of the Lombard Sign Ordinance includes provisions for temporary off-premise signs associated with events sponsored by non-profit organizations. The signs would be placed at Lombard Lagoon, the intersection of Main Street and St. Charles Road, and the intersection of Crescent Boulevard and St. Charles Road. This approval would only be valid for July 19, 2007 through July 22, 2007.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Village Board grant the request for the use of public right-of-way for temporary signage in conjunction with the event as described above.
