- **WHEREAS**, In August of 1912, ground was broken for the church and the first mass in the new church was held on Palm Sunday in 1913; and
- **WHEREAS,** over the years, Sacred Heart Church continued to grow and in 1914 the rectory was built and in 1925 the convent was built; and
- **WHEREAS,** as the number of parishioners grew, the original church became too small and in 1958
- **WHEREAS**, the Congregation plays a leadership role in Lombard Interfaith activity and supporting the hungry and the homeless; and
- **WHEREAS,** in honor of the Congregation Etz Chaim's 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary in April, several activities are being planned to be held on April 16, 17 and 18;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, William J. Mueller, President of the Village of Lombard, do hereby proclaim April 16-18, 2010 as Congregation ETZ CHAIM'S 50<sup>TH</sup>
