Subject: FY10 State Bid Vehicle Purchase

Included in the FY 2010 budget are the replacements for two (2) Public Works Street Department tandem axle dump trucks with plows and salt spreaders (unit # ST339 and # ST325). State bid for this type of vehicle has been awarded to Prairie International Trucks (contract # 4015048) of Springfield (IL). The cost of each unit is \$159,733 or \$319,466 for both. Prairie International has offered a \$28,000 trade-in allowance for our old trucks; this makes the total amount needed for this purchase \$291,466. The budgeted amount for this purchase is \$170,000 each or \$340,000 for both.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Prairie International of Springfield (IL) in the amount of \$291,466 for two (2) tandem axle dump trucks. I also recommend declaring Village unit # ST339 and # ST325 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing their trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the February 5, 2009 meeting.

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain the following described personal property:
