FY13 Vehicle Joint Purchase

Included in the FY13 budget is the replacement for the Deputy Police Chief's vehicle (2005 Ford Crown Vic unit # PA702). Unit PA702 is being replaced because it has 81,000 miles on it and the maintenance costs are rising (\$6,572 last year). Also since this vehicle travels a lot of miles (15,000 last year) staff would like to replace it with a more fuel efficient vehicle, a Ford Fusion. This would annually save approximately \$1,300 in fuel and reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 3 tons (see attached vehicle life cycle cost comparison). The Fusion is available for purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative.

The current contract winner for this vehicle is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The cost of the Fusion with options is \$17,118 (see attached proposal). The budgeted amount we have in reserve for this purchase is \$23,000 and we will see additional proceeds from the sale of unit # PP702 at auction. Copies of the FY13 vehicle replacement request and overall replacement program for FY13 have been included for your consideration.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$17,118 for one new Ford Fusion. I also recommend declaring Village unit # PA702 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its sale at public auction. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the October 18, 2012 meeting.

ORDINANCE	

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE BY PUBLIC AUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard, it is no longer necessary or useful to or in the best interest for the Village of Lombard to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described; and

- Section 2: Pursuant to said 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village President and Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the Village of Lombard, at public auction, at Americas Automobile Auction grounds in Crestwood, Illinois to the highest bidder on said property. Vehicles valued less than the cost of auction fees and would not result in a net profit for the Village shall be sold directly to a salvage yard.
