SUBJECT: Downtown Improvement & Renovation Grant; 106 W. St. Charles Road (Desert

Rose Design)

The Community Development Department has received an application for the Downtown Improvement and Renovation Grant Program (also known as the Facade Grant Program) for the property located at 106 W. St. Charles Road (Desert Rose Design). The property owner is seeking to replace the existing vinyl awning, install window graphics and repaint the exterior of the building.

# **Grant Request**

The property owner is seeking to replace the existing vinyl awning, install window graphics and repaint the exterior of the building. The applicant has submitted three bids for the proposed work and it is broken down as follows:

# Proposed Awning

The applicant has submitted the attached design showing a replacement of the existing red vinyl awning. The replacement awning would be constructed of fabric material and would remain red in color. Included on the awning would be "DRD", acronym for "Desert Rose Design". The awning and signage would meet Village Code. As shown above, the applicant has provided three (3) bids for the proposed new awning. The lowest bid submitted is \$1,850. Based on the lowest bid, the applicant is eligible to receive up to \$947.50 from the Facade Grant program.

# Proposed Window Graphics

The applicant is proposing graphics on their widow to assist in advertising their business. The graphics would include a design, yet to be determined, on either side of the front entrance door as well as coverings on the front doors. Graphics are considered an eligible expense for the façade grant. Therefore, the proposed window signage could be included as an eligible expense for the façade grant. This is consistent with past façade grant approvals (Bricks). The proposed window signage would also meet Village Code. The applicant has provided three (3) bids for the proposed window graphics. The lowest bid submitted is \$518. Based on the lowest bid, the applicant is eligible to receive up to \$259 from the Facade Grant program.

# Painting

As part of the applicants facade work, they also are proposing to paint portions of the exterior. The work will occur under the exterior ceiling panels, fascia and window trim. The applicant has provided three (3) bids for the proposed paint work. The lowest bid submitted is \$600. Based on the lowest bid, the applicant is eligible to receive up to \$300 from the Facade Grant program.

### Downtown Plan

As part of the Downtown Lombard Revitalization Project Guidebook, recommendations were provided for façade enhancements (section attached). The recommendations in the plan show this site having an angled awning as proposed. Staff finds that the plans are consistent with the recommendations within the Downtown Plan as it is providing new fabric materials with a strong visual impact. Staff would encourage the applicant to provide some type of "Gooseneck" lighting as shown in the Downtown Plan. The cost associated with this work could be eligible for the grant. The applicant did meet with the Lombard Town Centre prior to submitting their application. The Lombard Town Centre is supportive of the improvements.

### **Findings**

Based on the lowest bid, the applicant is eligible to receive up to \$1,506.50 from the Improvement and Renovation Grant program. Because the request is under \$10,000, it does not require approval from the Board of Trustees and can be approved by the ECDC.

Staff is supportive of the request for the following reasons:

- 1. Consistent with the recommendations of the Downtown Lombard Revitalization Project Guidebook.
- 2. Strong visual enhancement.
- 3. Consistent with past approvals for other façade grant requests.

It should be noted that all grant requests paid for by Village of Lombard TIF dollars shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act. Therefore, if the grant is approved, the applicant and property owner shall sign an acknowledgement form indicating that they are aware that this project is subject to prevailing wages.


# **Action Requested**

Thank you for the opportunity to quote on the graphics for the front windows of your studio.

# Front Doors: \$174 for both doors excluding installation and 8.25% sales tax

- Each door glass surface is 24" wide by 76" high.
- Etched vinyl applied to the entire glass area on the inside of the two doors with the address and company name cut out of the vinyl.

# Above Door Sign: \$280 excluding installation and 8.25% sales tax

- One clear Plexiglas ¼" thick by 48" wide by 18" high with finished edges affixed to outside of existing window.
- White vinyl applied to the first surface of the Plexiglas with the website address.

# <u>Interior Windows (adjacent to front doors): \$346 excluding installation and 8.25%</u> sales tax

- Two double-sided smooth vinyl banner material stabilized (but not secured to the floor) with a gripper bar on the bottom and suspended from the crown molding at the top of the window with a gripper bar at the top of the banner.
- Graphics printed on both sides of the banner.

Once the artwork is finalized, installation could be completed within two weeks. Installation for all items is \$290. No sales tax applies to the installation cost.
