A GIFT OF GIVING continues as the MM Foundation raised \$6,000 for this year's Lombard Junior Woman's Club sponsored TLC Camp through its annual golf outing. The foundation has donated \$86,500 to TLC Camp over the past 15 years. The donations have allowed hundreds of children with cancer and a sibling to experience a fun-filled week of activities and field trips at TLC Camp. The MM Foundation is a charity organization founded in memory of Melvin Moran by his wife, Rosemary, his sons John, Richard, Michael, Gregory, Thomas and Anthony, and their families. Moran lost his fight to a rare cancer in 1995. A golf outing is held every year to raise funds for the foundation. The foundation has also donated over \$83,000 to families and other organizations in the community, and the surrounding area, with direct financial support for medical and emotional needs for those faced with the struggle against cancer.
