

ORDINANCE NO. 6406

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 97
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO DIRECTIONAL STREET SIGNS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.300 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

“§ 97.300 DIRECTIONAL STREET SIGN; DEFINED.

For purposes of this Code, a “Directional Street Sign” shall be defined as follows: A sign located within the public right-of-way, which provides only a name and direction arrow indicating the location of a not-for-profit organization’s facility, a school district’s or unit of local government’s facility, or the historic downtown area of the Village (that area of downtown Lombard located within the boundaries of the Village’s T.I.F. District), or which identifies the name of a roadway at the access point to a Planned Unit Development (PUD) of not less than five (5) acres in size.”

SECTION 2: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301(B)(3) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by substituting a period for “ ; and ” at the end thereof.

SECTION 3: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301(C)(1) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by deleting the word “for” therefrom.

SECTION 4: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301(C) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the opening language thereof, prior to the subsections, to read in its entirety as follows:

“(C) Size and Format. Except in regard to Directional Street Signs relative to Village facilities or roadway name identification, the following size and format restrictions shall apply: ”

SECTION 5: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301(D) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the opening language thereof, prior to the subsections, to read in its entirety as follows:

“(D) Location. Except in regard to Directional Street Signs relative to Village facilities or roadway name identification, the following location restrictions shall apply:”

SECTION 6: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by relabeling subsection (E) as subsection (F).

SECTION 7: That Title 9, Chapter 97, Section 97.301 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding a new subsection (E) thereto, which shall read in its entirety as follows:

- “(E) Directional Street Signs which identify the name of a roadway shall be subject to the following requirements:
- (1) They shall consist of eight (8) inch white lettering on the top line, and four (4) inch white lettering on the bottom line, on a green background;
 - (2) Not more than one (1) shall be allowed on any street sign pole or traffic signal support; and
 - (3) Although an organization or entity may request a specific location for the Directional Street Sign, Directional Street Signs which identify the name of a roadway shall only be located at those locations approved by the Village’s Director of Public Works, or his/her designee.”

SECTION 8: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


