**SUBJECT: Ordinance Amending Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A)
of the Lombard Village Code (bowling alleys)**

Ordinance 3312 approved by the Board of Trustees on September 20, 1990 added the Class "R" liquor license classification as follows:

Class "R" – Alcoholic beverages served for consumption
on the premises of bowling alleys.

At the current time, there is only one Class "R" liquor license which is issued to Lucky Strike Lanes located at 100 Yorktown.

While looking through Village Code, staff noted that the language describing the Class "R" liquor license classification, as it is currently written, does not match the language that was approved by Ordinance 3312. Village Counsel was contacted and prepared the attached ordinance for Village Board consideration. This ordinance revises the descriptive language of the Class "R" liquor license classification only and does not affect any other sections of Title 11, Chapter 112 of Village Code.

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.12(A)
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO
THE CLASS "R" LIQUOR LICENSE (BOWLING ALLEYS)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the language therein, relative to the Class "R" liquor license, to read in its entirety as follows:

"Class "R" – Alcoholic beverages served for consumption on the premises of a bowling alley."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
